

Peter Thompson. Biography

Peter was born in London England in 1939. He was educated by the Xavarian Brothers at Clapham College and at sixteen entered the Holy Ghost Fathers to test a vocation to the ordained priesthood. This however was not to be his calling, and on leaving the seminary at eighteen he was required to do two years of national service with the military, serving with the RAF in early warning radar. He is married to Madeleine and they celebrated their 55th. anniversary in March of 2017. They have three children, fourteen grandchildren, and three great grandchildren. Peter & Madeleine, together with their three young children emigrated to Canada in 1967 and worked in the retail display and design field for twenty years.

During a crisis in their marriage and in faith in 1974, Peter and Madeleine were introduced to the then blossoming Catholic charismatic renewal. At an early stage he was called into leadership and developed his teaching skills. In 1990 with the call by Pope John Paul II to a decade of Evangelization, Peter and Madeleine were invited by Sion Catholic community for evangelization in England to join the community. They spent the next two years with the parish mission team doing extensive door to door evangelization and street ministry. This gave him a love for Catholic Apologetics which has developed over the years. For twenty years he taught at the John Paul II Catholic Bible school in Radway Alberta. He served on the Canadian national committee for the CCR from 1998 to 2010 and was appointed by iccrs in 2003 and completed two terms that were both extended by a year. Since 1998 Peter has served with Renewal Ministries traveling extensively in a number of African countries, and was appointed as country coordinator for Kenya in 2004. Peter is also a professional watercolour artist and continues to support his apostolate through the
